## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS October 24, 2012

**☐#1 Council Organizational Changes** – Municipal District of Bonnyville Ward 2 Councillor David Fox was appointed Deputy Reeve for the second year. There were minimal changes to Committee appointments, with Council voting to remain on the same committees for a second year to provide continuity with projects. Mr. John Ilchuk was appointed to the Subdivision and Development Appeal Board. Council agreed to increase the Meal Subsistence Rates to \$15 for breakfast, \$20 for lunch and \$25 for dinner. Council will continue to meet every second and fourth Wednesday of the month at 9:30 a.m. in Council Chambers. The Council Meetings for Wednesday November 14 and December 26 have been cancelled due to attendance at the AAMD&C Conference and the day being a statutory holiday respectively.

**☐#2 Please Don't Park On Residential Approaches** – The Public Safety Department will be erecting “No Parking” signs on residential approaches where people have been leaving their cars for the day when they car pool to work. The issue is happening on the large common driveway approaches. In some instances the parked vehicles are blocking the ability to exit or enter the property. The M.D. is urging commuters not to leave their cars blocking any public access routes. Earlier this year the Public Safety Department began patrolling the La Corey North Resource Road starting at 5 a.m. due to the high volume of traffic. This has been reviewed and Officers will continue to patrol during peak traffic periods. The County of Vermilion River, which is starting a Peace Officer Program, visited the M.D.'s Public Safety Department on the suggestion of the provincial government to review how we operate.

**☐#4 Transportation and Utilities News** – Council agreed to set a 1,000 gallon per day limit for bulk water haulers using the Fort Kent facility to ensure that there is enough water in the reservoir for hamlet usage and possible emergencies. Large bulk water tankers were drawing down the reservoir to dangerous levels.

**☐#5 Briefs, Briefs, Briefs** – The Bonnyville and District Centennial Centre presented the 2013 budget to Council requesting a total Municipal Contribution of \$1,848,508 with the M.D. contributing \$895,048 and the Town of Bonnyville contributing \$953,460.
