□#2 Public Safety Keeping Busy – Director of Public Safety, Chris Garner says Peace Officers are keeping busy. Last February saw 126 tickets issued and 19 written warnings given. In 2015, officers handed out 303 tickets and 85 warnings. Garner said while traffic has lessened, offences have not.

□#3 No New Class II Landfill in the M.D. – Council decided against installing a Class II Landfill in the M.D. A study conducted by the regional waste commission (made up of the M.D., Town of Bonnyville and City of Cold Lake) identified four possible sites in the M.D. However, Council says the landfill is not economically feasible and is not a benefit to the residents of the M.D.

□#4 Agriculture and Waste Services Update – The M.D.’s Coyote and Wolf Reduction Program continues to see success, with 1,144 coyotes and 34 wolves brought in to date. The M.D. has received a Tire Marshalling Grant of \$30,000 to build a marshalling area at the Goodridge Landfill. Construction will begin this spring.

□#5 Tenders Awarded – Council approved a number of tenders to be awarded, including the 2015 Summer Gravel Haul. Transportation and Utilities Director, Darcy Zelisko, worked out a solution with the lowest bidder (Edmonton-based People’s Trucking Ltd with a bid of 25.79 cents per tonne, per mile) that would see some preferred, local haulers hired to fulfil the tender. In a recorded vote, Reeve Ed Rondeau and Councillors Don Sinclair, Fred Bamber and Dana Swigert approved the tender, while Deputy Reeve Dave Fox and Councillors Mike Krywiak and Barry Kalinski voted against the tender.

Other tenders awarded included: Moose Lake Trail Paving to Redco Construction for \$329,280, Therien Sidewalk Construction to McAllister Site Services Ltd. for \$7,200, 2015 Water Hauling to CD6 Contracting Ltd. for \$95 per hour, Fencing Services to Dave’s Custom, 2015 Dust Suppressant Supply to Koretech for MG30 at \$4,780 per mile and MG60 at \$6,316 per mile. The 12.5 mm Cold Mix Supply tender was awarded to Grynn Contracting at \$74.50 per tonne to a maximum of \$894,000. Grynn was also awarded the tender for the 20 mm Cold Mix Supply. The tender for 2015 ACP Mix Type M1 was awarded to E-Construction at a price of \$81.99 per tonne, to a maximum of \$2,459,700. The underground portion of Ardmore’s Phase III project was awarded to Kichton Contracting Ltd for \$2,092,415, while MCL Group Ltd was awarded the tender for the storm pond for Ardmore’s Phase III at \$236,797.49. The tender for the base paving of Range Road 485A was awarded to Knelsen Sand & Gravel for \$3,065,759. Bids for the Gurneyville Road re-construction came in over budget. Council tabled making a decision on the tender until they could review the budget.

☐#6 Funding Support – Council agreed to donate \$300 to cover the cost of a Coffee Break at the Northern Lights Library System’s 25th annual conference. Council agreed to enter two teams in the Big Pyrogy Bonspiel at a cost of \$150.

☐#7 Briefly – Council agreed to draft a letter of support for the Centennial Centre to apply for a Government of Alberta Community Operating Grant to hire a Marketing Representative for a two-year-period. Doug Geier from Integra Air came to announce that as of April 13, the airline will be flying out of the Bonnyville Regional Airport to Calgary five days a week.
