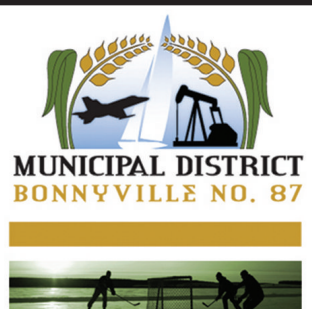

PUBLIC HEARING

Take notice that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 is proposing to pass bylaws pursuant to Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act.

FILE NO: 2016-A-001

Land Use Bylaw No. LU 559 -

Bylaw No. 1207, being the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 Land Use Bylaw, be amended as follows:

THAT Schedule 1 - Land Use Bylaw Map be amended such that Part of the South West Quarter of Section 3, Township 61, Range 6, West of the Fourth Meridian (Part of SW 3-61-6-W4M - 146.45 Acres more or less) be designated from Agricultural "A" to Country Residential "CR" District as shown on the attached Appendix A, Map LU 559.

The Council will cause a Public Hearing to be held **Wednesday, March 23, 2016, at 10:00 A.M.** in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, 4905-50 Avenue, Bonnyville, Alberta at which time objections to the proposed bylaws may be made and discussed. Submissions to the Public Hearing should be made in writing.

A copy of the proposed bylaws and related documents may be reviewed at the above address between the hours of 8:30AM - 12:00 Noon and 1:00 PM - 4:30 PM during week days. Any written submissions must be provided two days prior to the scheduled hearing date.

PUBLIC HEARING

Take notice that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 is proposing to pass bylaws pursuant to Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act.

LAND USE BYLAW NO. 558

Bylaw No. 1207, being the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 Land Use Bylaw, be amended as follows:

AMENDMENT to the Land Use Bylaw No. 1207 – Part 6 – General Regulations – Section 48 – Keeping of Animals (Amendment LU 543 – Adopted October 22, 2014).

Existing:

- 48.1 The keeping of all animals is subject to the licensing and regulatory provisions of the current versions of Municipal District of Bonnyville Animal Control Bylaw and the Municipal District of Bonnyville Dog Control Bylaw.
- 48.2 No livestock or poultry, with the exception of dogs, cats, and other such domestic pets as are typically kept indoors, shall be kept on lots less than 1.2 hectares (3.0 acres) in size.
- 48.3 Subject to Section 48.1, on country residential use parcels (including the agricultural district, but excluding the hamlets) more than 1.2 hectares (3.0 acres) to 4.04 hectares (10.0 acres) in size, not more than a total of two (2) of the following may be kept: horses, cattle, pigs, donkeys, mules, goats, or exotic animals, or alternatively a total of twelve (12) fowl or rabbits, excluding offspring under 1 year of age.
- 48.4 A person may be allowed to keep animals, livestock, or fowl in excess of the number specified in Section 48.3 if, in the opinion of Development Authority, the site is a suitable for such use and it is determined that the additional numbers would not create a nuisance for neighbouring properties.
- 48.5 All animals, on a residential lot, are kept only for the private use and enjoyment of the residents of the lot.

To be amended to:

- 48.1 The keeping of all animals is subject to the licensing and regulatory provisions of the current versions of Municipal District of Bonnyville Animal Control Bylaw and the Municipal District of Bonnyville Dog Control Bylaw.
- 48.2 No livestock, with the exception of dogs, cats, and other such domestic pets as are typically kept indoors, shall be kept on lots less than 1.2 hectares (3.0 acres) in size.
- 48.3 Poultry/Fowl, with the exception of roosters, shall be kept on country residential use parcels (including the agricultural district and hamlets) with the following regulations:
 - (a) Existing parcels less than 0.6 hectares (1.5 acres) in size, not more than a total of twelve (12);
 - (b) Parcels more than 0.6 hectares (1.5 acres) to 4.04 hectares (10.0 acres) in size, not more than a total of twenty five (25);
 - (c) Owner of the poultry/fowl must reside on the parcel where the poultry/fowl are being kept;
 - (d) Pen shall be located in rear yard only and must be setback a minimum of 3 meters (9.8 feet) from side and rear property boundaries; and
 - (e) If the poultry/fowl house exceeds 13.9 square meters (150.0 square feet), development and building permits shall be required and shall meet the minimum setbacks of the district.
- 48.4 Subject to Section 48.1, on country residential use parcels (including the agricultural district, but excluding the hamlets) more than 1.2 hectares (3.0 acres) to 4.04 hectares (10.0 acres) in size, not more than a total of two (2) of the following may be kept: horses, cattle, pigs, donkeys, mules, goats, or exotic animals, or alternatively a total of twelve (12) rabbits, excluding offspring under 1 year of age.
- 48.5 A person may be allowed to keep animals, livestock, or fowl in excess of the number specified in Section 48.3 if, in the opinion of Development Authority, the site is suitable for such use and it is determined that the additional numbers would not create a nuisance for neighbouring properties.
- 48.6 All animals, on a residential lot, are kept only for the private use and enjoyment of the residents of the lot.
