The Municipal District of Bonnyville is now accepting applications for the following positions:

Heavy Duty Mechanic - This position is responsible to troubleshoot, service, repair and maintain Municipal District of Bonnyville equipment in the Transportation and Utilities Department. The successful candidate will also be responsible for providing appropriate records of work completed/performed on each unit. This opportunity will remain open until a suitable candidate is found.

Parks Equipment Operator – This full-time, year-round position will report to the Parks and Recreation Manager. Responsibilities will include supervising and mentoring of summer staff, campground and baseball diamond maintenance, and assisting with Kinosoo Ridge Snow Resort operations. This opportunity will remain open until a suitable candidate is found.

Temporary – Pest Control Officer – This is a six-month term position. 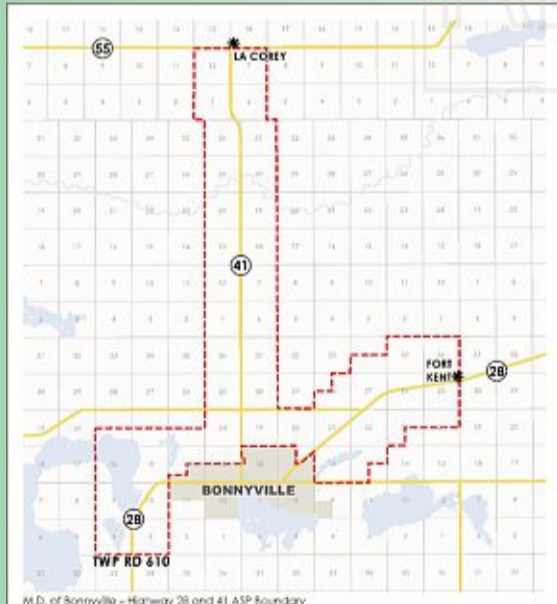
When: Thursday, April 5, 2018, 5:30 – 7:30 p.m. (presentation at 6:30 p.m.)

INVITATION FOR PRICING M.D. OF BONNYVILLE NO. 87 M.D. GRAVEL SUPPLY

The Municipal District of Bonnyville is requesting proposals for gravel supplier(s) as per the following conditions:

1. Supply of Alberta Transportation Specified Designation aggregate of various size
2. Pricing is to be supplied from the pit or stockpile location and the location of the pile is to be supplied for haul evaluation. Multiple pit locations may be provided with a minimum of 30,000 tonnes each.
3. Quality control testing of 1 sieve analysis per daily crush volumes of product are to be supplied by the gravel supplier and performed by a certified materials testing lab. Material may be rejected if out of required specification.
4. All material to be available and completed by specified date.
5. Multi-year supply proposals accepted.

The Municipal District of Bonnyville will be evaluating all submissions and will determine the selected supplier(s) based on location and pricing.
