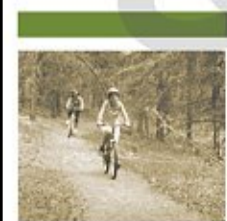

PUBLIC NOTICE TO ELECTORS OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF BONNYVILLE

SECTION 266 – THE MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT ACT

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 intends to guarantee a borrowing by Bonnyville and District Recreation Sports Association (Bonnyville Junior "A" Pontiacs Hockey Club) for the purposes of refinancing their outstanding debt. This ad notifies the public about the intent to guarantee the borrowing through a bylaw, outlines what the money will be used for, and identifies the process for public input.

WHAT:

The Bonnyville & District Sports & Recreation Society has approached the Lakeland Credit Union Ltd. in order to restructure their finances. Specifically, new funding is being sought in the form of a new term loan for \$250,000, and an authorized overdraft agreement for \$50,000 totaling \$300,000. The interest rate is proposed to be set at prime (3.45%) plus 2.00 percent.

The purpose for the new financing is as follows:

a.) 2018 partial operating costs	\$43,365
b.) Pay down outstanding payables	\$179,785
c.) Pay Visa	\$26,850
d.) Replenish operating cash	\$28,348

In order to secure the new funding proposal, the Lakeland Credit Union is requesting guarantees from the Town of Bonnyville and the M.D. of Bonnyville No. 87. in the amounts of \$150,000 each. Section 266(1) of the MGA permits a municipality to guarantee a loan between a third party and a non-profit organization by bylaw.

HOW TO COMMENT:

Notice is hereby given by the Council of the M.D. of Bonnyville No. 87 that, unless a petition of the Electors for a vote on Bylaw No.1690 is demanded, as provided for by the terms of Section 231 of the *Municipal Government Act*, the said Council may pass the said borrowing bylaw.

All persons interested are hereby notified and they are required to govern themselves accordingly.

INFORMATION FOR ELECTORS

Pursuant to Section 1(i) of the *Municipal Government Act*, an "elector" means: a person who is eligible to vote in the election for a councillor under the *Local Authorities Election Act*.

Pursuant to Section 47(1) of the *Local Authorities Election Act*, a person is eligible to vote in an election if the person:

- is at least 18 years old,
- is a Canadian citizen, and
- has resided in Alberta for the 6 consecutive months immediately preceding election day and the person's place of residence is located in the area on election day.

Pursuant to Section 223 (2) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a petition may be demanded in the M.D. of Bonnyville by electors of the municipality equal in number to at least 10% of the population.

Pursuant to Section 231(3) and 224(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, the petition for a vote must be received by the Chief Administrative Officer within 15 days of the last publication of this notice and shall contain on each page an identical statement of the purpose of the petition.

Further requirements of the petition are provided in Section 224 of the *Municipal Government Act*.

Pursuant to Section 266(1) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a municipality may only guarantee the repayment of a loan between a lender and a non-profit organization or one of its controlled corporations if the guarantee is authorized by bylaw.
