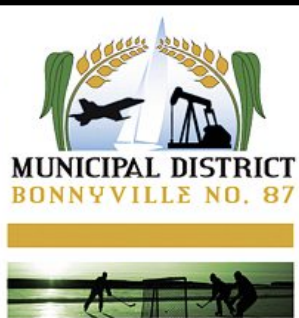

Take notice that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 is proposing to pass bylaws pursuant to Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act.

FILE NO: 2018-A-001

Land Use Bylaw No. LU 565 -
Bylaw No. 1667, being the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 Land Use Bylaw, be amended as follows:

THAT Schedule 1 - Land Use Bylaw Map be amended such that Part of the South West Quarter of Section 13, Township 63, Range 4, West of the Fourth Meridian (SW 13-63- 4-W4M - 149.56 Acres more or less) be designated from Rural Industrial "RI" to Agricultural "A" District as shown on the attached Schedule "A", Map LU No. 565.

The Council will cause a Public Hearing to be held **Wednesday, June 13, 2018, at 10:00 A.M.** in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, 4905-50 Avenue, Bonnyville, Alberta at which time objections to the proposed bylaws may be made and discussed. Submissions to the Public Hearing should be made in writing.

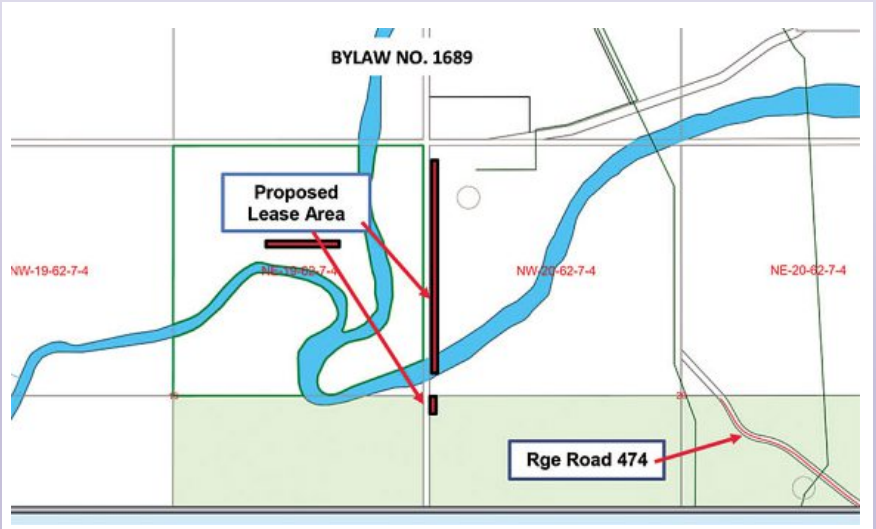
LICENCE FOR TEMPORARY OCCUPATION AND LEASE OF GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE

Take notice that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87, under authority of Section 13(1)(o) of the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-6, R.S.A. 2000, intends to pass a bylaw granting a license or a permit for the temporary occupation or use of a road allowance as follows:

All that portion of government road allowance between the North East Quarter of Section 19 and the North West Quarter of Section 20, Township 62, Range 7, W4M (NE of 19 / NW 20-62-7-W4M).

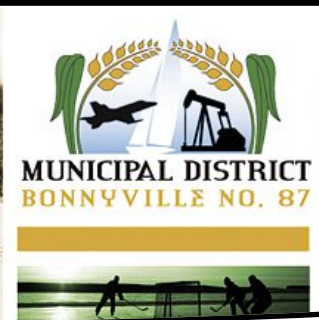


SCHEDULE "A", MAP LUB #565

ROADSIDE SPRAYING PROGRAM 2018

The Agricultural Service Board of the M.D. of Bonnyville No. 87 and/or Contractors will commence spraying roadside ditches along provincial highways and other municipal roads, as required to control the spread of weeds and brush growth on or about June 1 and through the summer until the end of September.

Those landowners living along a Primary or Secondary Highway who are prepared to control the weeds along their property should contact Alberta Transportation, the maintenance contractor that looks after these highways. You will be asked to sign a Weed Control Agreement stating that you accept responsibility for the control of weeds in the ditch along your property. If you fail to control these by mowing or spraying, the M.D. or Alberta Transportation may control them by whatever means it considers appropriate.

Landowners are reminded that the road allowances are owned by the M.D. or by the Province in the case of Provincial Highways and any activity carried out within the road allowances are done at each persons own risk.
