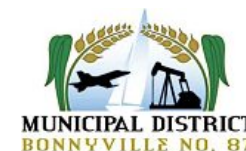
Rural Beautification Contest Nominations Now Open

LICENCE FOR TEMPORARY OCCUPATION AND LEASE OF GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE

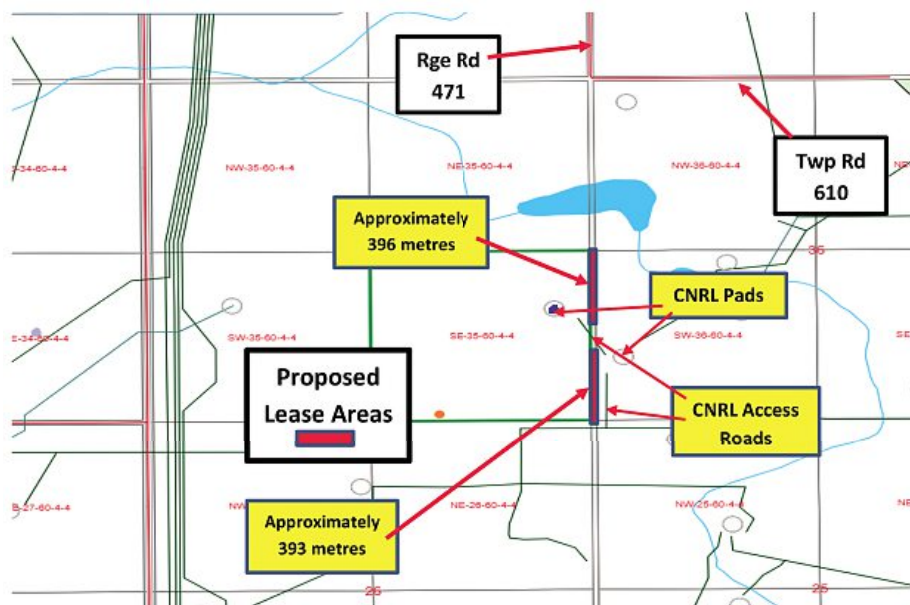
