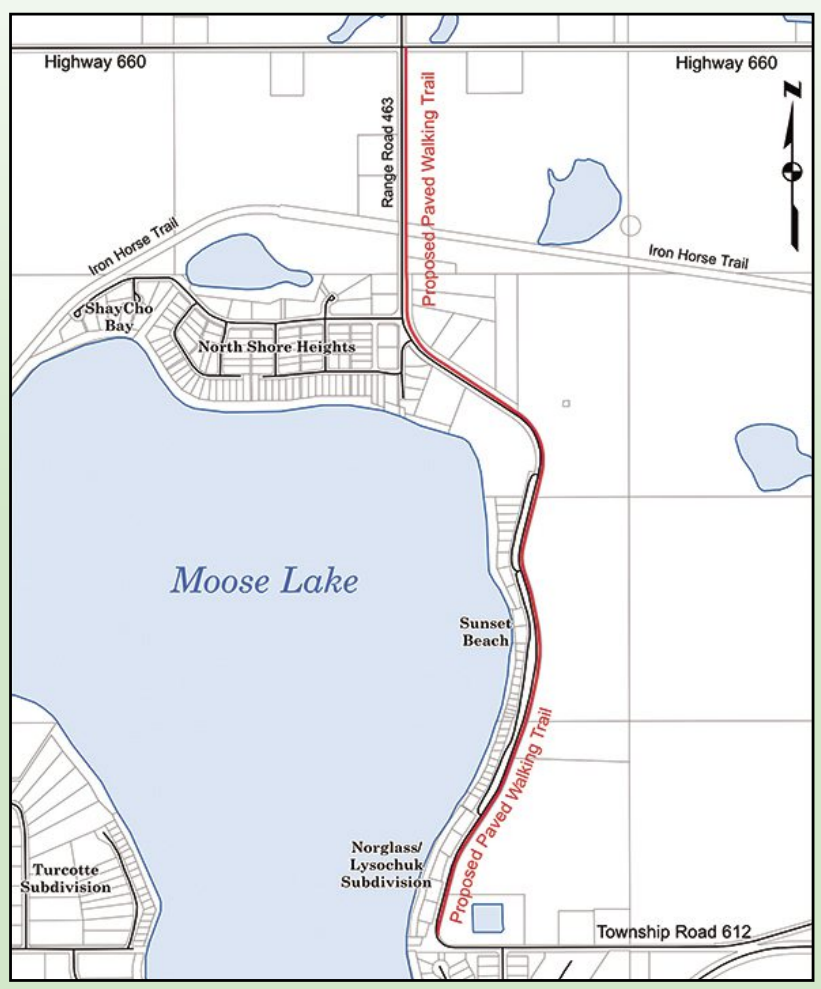
The Open House will be an opportunity for you to speak with project planners and MD Staff regarding the project. The Open House is scheduled on:
