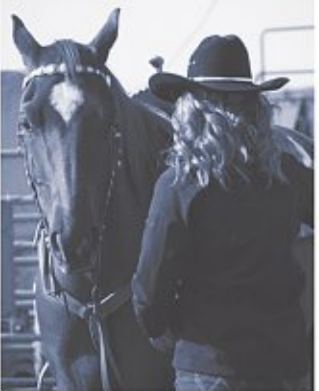
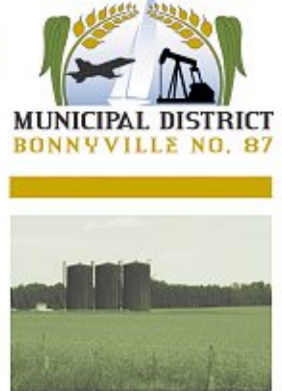

Municipal Election 2017

Applications are currently being accepted for the positions of Presiding Deputy and Deputy Returning Officers for the 2017 Municipal Election to be held Monday, October 16.

The M.D. of Bonnyville is seeking qualified personnel to fill these positions at voting stations throughout the municipality.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Setting up and managing the voting station
- Assisting and educating electors in the voting process
- Overseeing the new electronic voting system
- Coordinating required documentation
- Maintaining peace and order in the voting station

All Deputy Returning Officers will be required to attend a half-day training session in early October and will be expected to work at a specific polling station from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Election Day. Previous experience with a Municipal Election would be a definite asset.
