The M.D. of Bonnyville is seeking qualified personnel to fill these positions at voting stations throughout the municipality.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Setting up and managing the voting station
- Assisting and educating electors in the voting process
- Overseeing the new electronic voting system
- Coordinating required documentation
- Maintaining peace and order in the voting station

All Deputy Returning Officers will be required to attend a half-day training session in early October and will be expected to work at a specific polling station from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Election Day. Previous experience with a Municipal Election would be a definite asset.
