

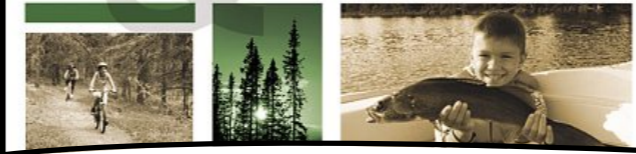

### Land Use Bylaw No. LU 569 -

Bylaw No. 1667, being the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 Land Use Bylaw, be amended as follows:

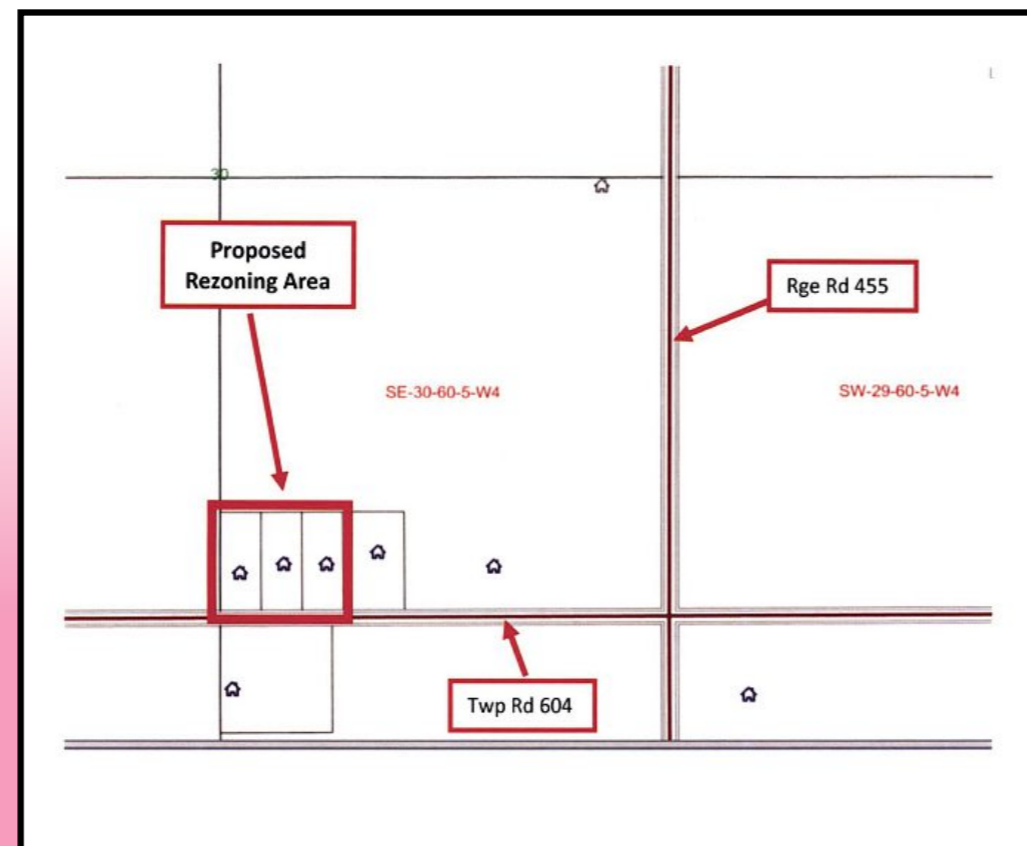
THAT Schedule 1 - Land Use Bylaw Map be amended such that Lots 3, 4 & 5, Block 1, Plan 062 7848 within the South East Quarter of Section 30, Township 60, Range 5, West of the Fourth Meridian (Lots 3, 4 & 5, Block 1, Plan 062 7848 within SE 30-60-5- W4M - 10.02 Acres more or less) be designated from Country Residential "CR" to Agricultural "A" District as shown on the attached Schedule "A", Map LU No. 569.

The Council will cause a Public Hearing to be held **Wednesday, October 24, 2018, at 11:00 A.M.** in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, 4905-50 Avenue, Bonnyville, Alberta at which time objections to the proposed bylaws may be made and discussed. Submissions to the Public Hearing should be made in writing.

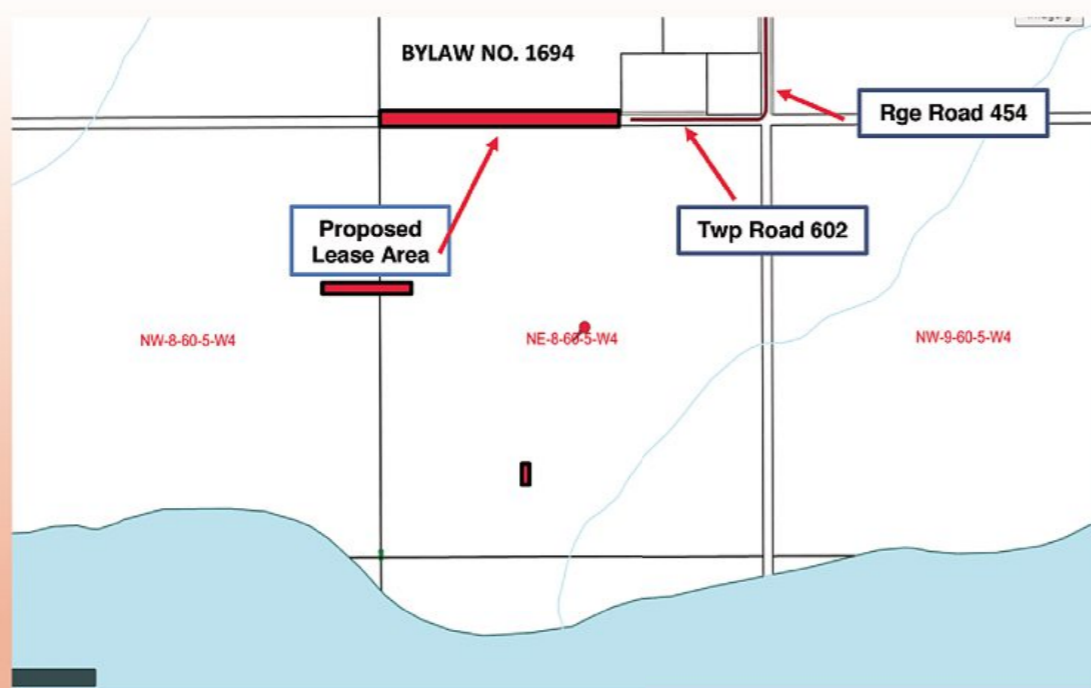
### LICENCE FOR TEMPORARY OCCUPATION AND LEASE OF GOVERNMENT ROAD ALLOWANCE

Take notice that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87, under authority of Section 13(1)(o) of the Traffic Safety Act, Chapter T-6, R.S.A. 2000, intends to pass a bylaw granting a license or a permit for the temporary occupation or use of a road allowance as follows:

All that portion of the government road allowance North of the North East Quarter of Section 8, Township 60, Range 5, W4M (N / NE 8-60-5-W4M) commencing at the NW corner of the said NE 8-60-5-W4M thence Easterly for a distance of 520 metres (1,706 feet) more or less.
