

# Siberian Larch



Larch can reach a height of 50 to 65 ft. with a spread of up to 25 ft. It can live up to 100 years with a growth rate of up to 8 to 60 in. a year.

Needles turn yellow in fall before dropping off in winter.

Siberian Larch are found on a wide range of soil textures. They grow best on moist, light, well-drained soils, and is adaptable to dry conditions. Fair tolerance to drought. They require full sun.

Larch is fully winter hardy.
