



2019 Landfill/Transfer Station Spring Update

Tips for making your trip to the landfill/transfer station a little bit smoother

1. **Propane Tanks** – put in designated propane tank collection area. Propane tanks are dangerous goods and are a hazard to our metal recyclers when found in metal pile.
2. **Metal** – effective Fall 2018, there is to be no more picking from the metal piles for commercial dealers. Trailers and trucks with pickers will be sent away. For those looking for small parts you are not permitted to be climbing the pile.
3. **Wire, barbed wire, wire paneling** – please put in designated wire area.
4. **Cardboard** – remove Styrofoam and plastic and break down your boxes
5. **Shingles** – when taking shingles to La Corey please remove metal, wood, plastics, paper, and waste from your load. We grind our shingles to be reused and waste material is a hazard and a downgrade to the product. Dirty loads will be charged double the rate.
6. **Electronics** – only designated electronics in cages. Appliances to metal or waste.
7. **Paint** – empty metal paint cans into tin can recycling bin. Empty plastic paint cans into household waste.
8. **Mattresses/Boxsprings** – place clean units in sea can for recycling. Soiled units will need to go in the pit.
9. **Twine** – producers can pick up clear bags for their baler twine for FREE at any landfill or at the M.D. Public Works shop.
10. **Oil** – please be prepared to unload your own oil and containers. Landfill operators have a lid remover tool for users to remove the lids from 5 gallon pails, but it is not their responsibility to unload your oil and containers.
