## PUBLIC HEARING

Take notice that the Council of the Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 is proposing to pass bylaws pursuant of Section 692 of the Municipal Government Act.

**Bylaw No. LU 464** – To amend Bylaw No. 1207, being the Land Use Bylaw for rezoning **SE 21-63-2-W4M, Plan 082 0072 Block 1 Lot 2 (144 acres more or less)** from Agricultural (A) to Rural Industrial (RI) for Cold Lake Industrial Park located 1 mile west of the City of Cold Lake on Highway 55.

**Bylaw No. LU 465** – To amend Bylaw No. 1239, being the Highway 55 Area Structure Plan to designate **SE 21-63-2-W4M, Plan 082 0072 Block 1 Lot 2 (144 acres more or less)** from Agricultural (A) to Rural Industrial (RI) for Cold Lake Industrial Park located 1 mile west of the City of Cold Lake on Highway 55.

The Council will cause a Public Hearing to be held **Wednesday, November 25, 2009 at 10:15 a.m.** in the Council Chambers, Municipal Office, 4905-50 Avenue, Bonnyville, Alberta at which time objections to the proposed bylaws may be made and discussed. ## SHELTERBELT PROGRAM DEADLINE MARCH 15

The deadline to apply for trees under the Prairie Shelterbelt Program is March 15, 2010.

Shelterbelt trees are free of charge, with clients paying shipping costs. Applications for the program are accepted from June 1 to March 15 for May delivery. Seedlings are shipped to the M.D. office where residents can pick them up. Application forms are available at the M.D. Agriculture Office, by calling the PFRA (Prairie Farm Rehabilitation Administration) toll free number at 1-866-766-2284 or by logging on to [http://www.agr.gc.ca/pfra/shelterbelt\\_e.htm](http://www.agr.gc.ca/pfra/shelterbelt_e.htm).

Residential acreage owners in the M.D. of Bonnyville can now take advantage of the Prairie Shelterbelt Program. To qualify for the program in 2010 landowners are only required to have five acres or more.

Community service organizations and watershed groups can access seedlings for planting projects on eligible land with a signed application from the landowner.
