ELECTION WORKERS MUNICIPAL ELECTION 2021

Applications are currently being accepted for the positions of Presiding Deputy and Deputy Returning Officers (election workers) for the 2021 Municipal Election to be held Monday, October 18, 2021.

The M.D. of Bonnyville is seeking qualified personnel to fill these positions at voting stations throughout the municipality.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Setting up and managing the voting station
- Assisting and educating electors in the voting process
- Overseeing the new electronic voting system
- Coordinating required documentation
- Maintaining peace and order in the voting station

All Deputy Returning Officers will be required to attend a half-day training session in early October and will be required to work at a specific polling station from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. on Election Day. Previous experience with a Municipal Election would be a definite asset.

GOODBYE TENT HELLO UGLY - NEST ARCHIPS CERASIVORANA

- Native to Canada & Northeastern USA
- Named after its untidy, nest forming characteristics
- Feeds on black cherry, choke cherry, roses & hawthorns
- Will feed on aspens, poplar & birch during outbreaks
- Outbreaks are sporadic & may be absent for several years
- Damaged caused by the caterpillars will not damage the tree



LIFE CYCLE

- Larvae can be found feeding on a host from May to September
- Larvae are yellow to greenish - yellow with blackheads
- Larvae construct nests with leaves & branches from the host tree that are tied together with dense webbing
- Larvae feed as a group within the nest & expand as necessary
- Larvae pupate in the nest between mid-June to September
- Adult moth forewings are speckled with dark, reddish, brown markings and the hind wings are solid, bright orange in color



CONTROL

- There is no need to control ugly - nest caterpillars, however; your tree will look aesthetically unpleasant
- During occasional outbreaks you can rely on natural enemies to control the populations
- You can cut the webs off the tree and burn them
- Chemical control is very rarely required
