Following Province of Alberta guidelines, as of June 19, 2020, all Municipal District of Bonnyville owned/operated campgrounds will be implementing changes based around Phase II. This includes opening up group areas, tent sites, washrooms/outhouses, fish cleaning stands, picnic shelters, beaches, and day use areas. Playgrounds were reopened in May. All of these facilities are "use at your own risk";

Washrooms and outhouses will be sanitized or cleaned as per provincial guidelines.

Camping During COVID-19

Located on the shores of Cold Lake, The Cold Lake M.D. Park is a short five-minute walk from Kinosoos Beach, which boasts basketball and beach volleyball courts, concession, splash park and zipline to drop you right into the lake. There are events held at Kinosoos Beach all summer including Canada Day and Aqua Day on the August long weekend. Both events culminate with fireworks at the Cold Lake Marina, a 15-minute walk away.

Check out the lakeshore area, which boasts a number of restaurants including homestyle, Mexican, Mediterranean, waffles and more.

CAMPGROUND GUIDE

RULES & REGULATIONS

- No person shall interfere with the rights of others to the quiet and peaceful enjoyment of the park.
- Please also refrain from running your generators continuously throughout the day.
- There will be zero tolerance for excessive noise from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.**
- Park guests are expected to maintain clean sites. Please use garbage bins for waste - not fire pits. Campsites left in an unacceptable condition may result in a fine of \$250.
- Alcohol is not allowed off of your assigned campsite at any time.
- Cannabis can only be used inside of your RV/tent.
- All dogs must be leashed AT ALL TIMES. Dogs are not allowed on the beach AT ANY TIME. Cleaning up after your pets is mandatory.
- The swimming and playground areas are NOT supervised. Use at own risk.
- Fireworks are prohibited in all M.D. Parks.
- ATVs are prohibited inside of the park.

Reservations are recommended at Cold Lake M.D. Park. The park office begins taking reservations April 2. Weather permitting, the park is open from May 14 to September 13, 2020. Bookings will be accepted via telephone and online. Stalls can only be guaranteed for the number of days reserved. The maximum stay is two weeks.

CANCELLATION POLICY

In the event that you have to cancel your reservation, please provide at least 72 hours notice, prior to your expected check-in. One night's stay will be deducted from your camping fees. Failure to notify the park caretaker 72 hours prior to check-in will result in the loss of your entire camping fee.

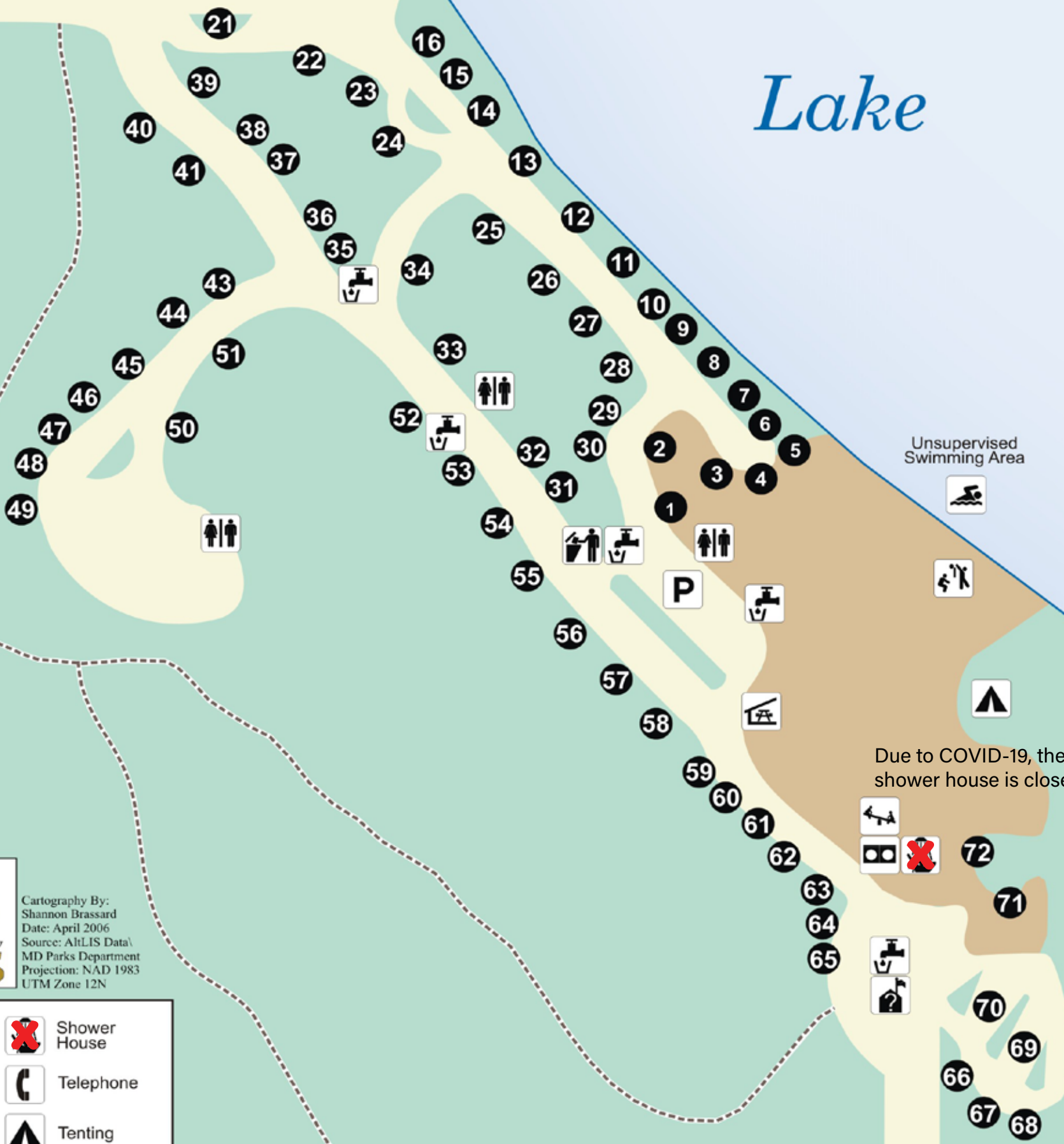
