It is up to you, our visitors, to camp responsibly during this time of COVID-19. You must maintain a social distance of at least six feet at all times, including when gathering outside in groups larger than 100 people. Please remember to wash or sanitize your hands frequently.

As always, if you aren't feeling well, please stay home.

Washrooms and outhouses will be sanitized or cleaned as per provincial guidelines.

Following Province of Alberta guidelines, as of June 19, 2020, all Municipal District of Bonnyville owned/operated campgrounds will be implementing changes based around Phase II. This includes opening up group areas, tent sites, washrooms/outhouses, fish cleaning stands, picnic shelters, beaches, and day use areas. Playgrounds were reopened in May. All of these facilities are "use at your own risk";

Camping During COVID-19

Crane Lake is one of the most popular lakes in our region, and with good reason. Its clear, cool water, and sandy shore make it a favourite amongst watersport enthusiasts. The lake itself is picturesque while being only a short distance off the beaten path. Bring your bicycles and travel between the East and West parks. From playgrounds to ice cream, there's always a reason to take a short ride. There are two parks in the Crane Lake Park, each with its own unique attractions. The park office is located in the West Park, and firewood is sold in both areas.

SURROUNDINGS

In the event that you have to cancel your reservation, please provide at least 72 hours notice, prior to your expected check-in. One night's stay will be deducted from your camping fees. Failure to notify the park caretaker 72 hours prior to check-in will result in the loss of your entire camping fee. CANCELLATION POLICY

Reservations are recommended at Crane Lake M.D. Park. The park office begins taking reservations April 2. Weather permitting, the park is open from May 14 to September 13, 2020. Bookings will be accepted via telephone or online at www.campreservations.ca/welcome. Stalls can only be guaranteed for the number of days reserved. The maximum stay is two weeks.

RULES & REGULATIONS

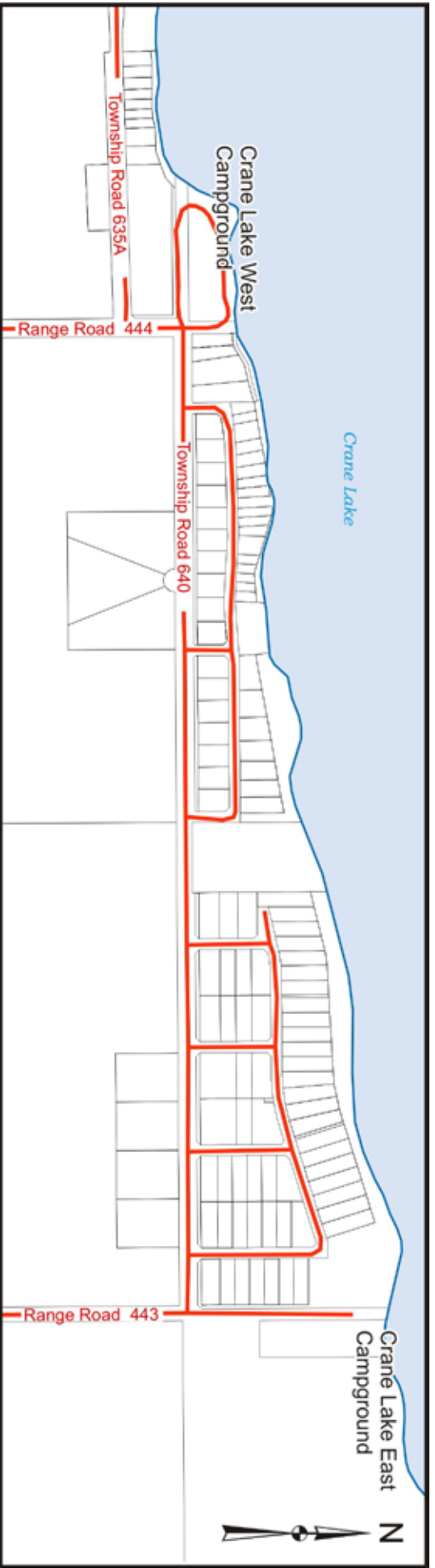
- No person shall interfere with the rights of others to the quiet and peaceful enjoyment of the park.
- Please also refrain from running your generators continuously throughout the day.
- **There will be zero tolerance for excessive noise from 11 p.m. to 7 a.m.**
- Park guests are expected to maintain clean sites. Please use garbage bins for waste - not fire pits. Campsites left in an unacceptable condition may result in a fine of \$250.
- Alcohol is not allowed off of your assigned campsite at any time.
- Cannabis can only be used inside of your RV/tent.
- All dogs must be leashed AT ALL TIMES. Dogs are not allowed on the beach AT ANY TIME. Cleaning up after your pets is mandatory.
- The swimming and playground areas are NOT supervised. Use at own risk.
- Fireworks are prohibited in all M.D. Parks.
- ATVs are prohibited inside of the park.
