

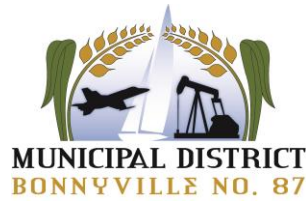
The Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87 invites interested tenders for “Landfill Servicing” of the 7 municipal landfill/transfer stations for a three (3) year term commencing July 1, 2019.

The “Landfill Servicing” requirements are as follows –

1. Site visits with bulldozer (estimated)
 - a. Mid-October through Mid-April –
 - i. Ardmore, Hilda Lake, La Corey, Fort Kent – **twice per month** with one hour of on-site work at each site.
 - ii. Therien, Goodridge – **once per month** with one hour of on-site work at each site.
 - b. Mid-April through Mid-October –
 - i. Ardmore, Hilda Lake, La Corey, Fort Kent – **once per week** with one hour of on-site work at each site.
 - ii. Therien, Goodridge, Muriel Lake – **once per month** with one hour of on-site work at each site.
2. Site visits with excavator and dump truck (estimated)
 - a. Once per year to each site to clean out burn cells and pile concrete
3. Equipment required – please state details
 - a. Bulldozer (make, model, HP) - _____
 - b. Excavator (make, model, HP) - _____
 - c. Truck and trailer for moving equipment.
 - d. Dump truck for moving material around sites.

The requirements of the “Landfill Servicing” contract include but are not limited to the following per site visit at any of the 7 landfill locations –

1. Supply own safety management system and be delegated as “Prime Contractor” as defined by the Occupational Health and Safety Act and shall fulfill all obligations and responsibilities associated with this designation, while on M.D. of Bonnyville sites.
2. Push Class 3 waste off face of pit onto pile to be compacted and buried.
3. Stack Class 3 waste and cover with 4-6” existing clay or waste dirt material as needed to compact and bury the waste.
4. Push up wood burning cells – Wood to be burned or ashes and rubble from previous burn



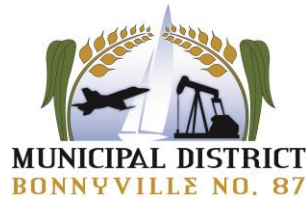
5. Push up metal pile
6. Push up compost pile
7. Push up tire pile
8. Seasonal Extras
 - a. Back blade ruts on site during wet seasons
 - b. Create fire guard around wood burning cells in spring and fall
 - c. Push snow and clear drainage areas for run off/run on control
 - d. Clean out wood burning cells as required

Tenderer's Requirements

1. The bidder is required to carry Commercial General Liability with a minimum limit of \$5,000,000.00 with an annual aggregate no lower than \$5,000,000.00 for both bodily injury and property damage. The coverage shall include Non-Owned Automobile coverage with a minimum limit of \$2,000,000.00.
2. The bidder is required to carry Commercial Automobile Third Party liability with a minimum limit of \$2,000,000.00

Based on these requirements please state the following notification time & hourly rates.

1. Notification time required before emergency/call out service can be provided

2. Bulldozer
 - a. Rate for one hour of on-site work including mobilization \$_____/hour
 - b. Rate per hour of on-site work after initial hour \$_____/hour
3. Excavator
 - a. Rate for one hour of on-site work including mobilization \$_____/hour
 - b. Rate per hour of on-site work after initial hour \$_____/hour
4. Dump Truck for one hour of on-site work including mobilization \$_____/hour
5. Rate per hour of on-site work after initial hour \$_____/hour
6. Rate for emergency call outs including mobilization (bulldozer) \$_____/hour
 - a. 2018 emergency call outs included –
 - i. Class 3 waste pit fire
 - ii. Wood burning cell fire where ashes flared up in the wind
 - iii. Excessive loads of commercial waste coming into La Corey landfill requiring waste to be pushed to maintain space for offloading.



Tender will be awarded based on following point system –

- 40% Rates
- 40% Prior experience with owner
- 10% Knowledge of landfill standards
- 10% Prior experience with landfills

If awarded the contract, the Contractor shall provide certification of insurance coverage, safety management system, and will be delegated as Prime Contractor.

The Municipality reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders and to waive irregularities and informalities at its discretion. The Municipality reserves the right to accept a tender other than the lowest tender without stating reasons. By the act of submitting its bid, the Bidder waives any right to contest in any legal proceeding or action the right of the Municipality to award the work to whomever it chooses, in its sole and unfettered discretion, and for whatever reasons the Municipality deems appropriate. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Municipality may consider any other factor besides price and capability to perform the work that it deems in its sole discretion to be relevant to its decision including but not limited to the following:

- Any past experience with the Bidder, or lack thereof;
- The results of any reference check done by the Municipality;
- Information relating to the financial state of the Bidder, however obtained.

The Municipal District of Bonnyville retains the option to cancel the bid process should an event occur beyond the Municipality's control which prevents the Municipality from proceeding.
